Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act Notice for Commercial Customers

In accordance with the requirements of the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 and Regulation GG, this notification is to inform you that restricted transactions are prohibited from being processed through your business account or relationship with our institution. Restricted transactions are transactions in which a person accepts credit, funds, instruments, or other proceeds from another person in connection with unlawful Internet gambling. Unlawful internet gambling means to place, receive or otherwise knowingly transmit a bet or wager by any means which involves the use, at least in part, of the internet where such bet or wager is unlawful under any Federal or State law in the State or Tribal lands in which the bet or wager is initiated, received or otherwise made.

By maintaining an account with our institution, you certify that you do not engage in internet gambling and you agree to notify us if your account is ever used for internet gambling of any kind even if you believe the activity to be legal.
